

## **Assembly instructions for Bluetooth- Junction box TomTom GL1800**

### **Installation of the Bluetooth-Junction-Box**

The junction box will be installed under the front left storage compartment. Remove the storage compartment.

Under the compartment you will find a 6pol intercom plug and a red 3pol power plug (12V ACC), disconnect the intercom plug and connect the open plug with the junction box connectors. Connect the 3pol power plug (12V vehicle voltage).

### **Installation of the Bluetooth Control Panel**

The control panel can be built into the left storage compartment. If only being for the first connect to the TomTom Rider.

### **Bluetooth connection to the TomTom Rider**

For the first contact to the TomTom Rider, all Bluetooth device must deleted from the device directory. Then reset the TomTom Rider.

The Bluetooth contact to the Junction box done in the same way as the connection with the original headset.

For a connection to the Bluetooth-junction box must be prepared as follows:

Ignition switch on (ACC position).

Select in the TomTom menu "connect with headset".

Press the button from the Bluetooth control panel. Hold until the green LED a few times quickly flashes. Then release the button for one second. Then push the button and hold it until the green LED lights permanently.

Then in the TomTom Rider menu "connect with headset" touch OK and initiated the connection procedure (see the TomTom Rider manual). The Bluetooth junction box is detected as Jabra BT125.

Once the connection to Bluetooth-box was built, flashes the green LED on the panel in long intervals. The box is connected to the TomTom and can be used.

### **Test the Bluetooth connectivity**

Switch on the Ignition (ACC).

Connect the Helmet (with headset) with the intercom.

Trigger a Voice announcement on the TomTom Rider (touch on the right bottom of the screen).

If everything is connected, the announcement would have the navigation system in the helmet will be heard. The volume of the announcement may directly set on the screen of the TomTom Rider (touch on the right bottom of the screen).

If present a Bluetooth mobile phone can it connect with the (phone) free talk on the TomTom. Phone calls can be led on the helmet headset.

If everything works correctly, protect the junction box with a plastic bag and fasten it with a cable fixer. Fasten the junction Box carefully under the storage compartment (if needed use 2-sided adhesive tape).

Assemble all de-installed parts.
